Celebrating 25 Years!



HOMAGE TO LIBRARIES



The towering French novelist Victor Hugo proclaimed, "A library implies an act of faith which generations still in darkness hid sign in their night in witness of the dawn." Of the embracive democracy of libraries Lady Bird Johnson said, "Perhaps no place in any community is so totally democratic as the town library. The only entrance requirement is interest." Daniel Boorstin concurs: "Libraries remain the meccas of self-help, the most open of open universities, where there are no entrance examinations and no diplomas and where one can enter at any age."

Next month, our community will celebrate the twenty-fifth anniversary of our Library's opening on its current site. From its beginnings in a storefront to the beautiful and much-used building on Scripps Lake Drive, our community has been much enriched.
