


These Baker Creek Heirloom Seeds were donated to the

6	BEANS Rattlesnake Pole	 A collection of Rattlesnake Pole beans, including several long, thin green pods and a small white dish containing a mix of dried beans.
7	BEANS Red Swan Bush	 Red Swan Bush beans, shown as a small white dish with several purple pods and a larger white dish with a mix of dried beans.
8	BEETS Crosby's Egyptian	 Crosby's Egyptian beets, showing several whole beets with their green leafy tops and one sliced beet revealing its deep red interior, all on a wooden cutting board.
9	BROCCOLI Calabreses Green Sprouting	 A head of Calabreses Green Sprouting broccoli, showing its dense, green, sprouting florets and large, dark green leaves.
10	BROCCOLI Rapini	 A head of Rapini broccoli, showing its characteristic small, tight florets and long, green stalks, served on a white plate.
11	BROCCOLI Waltham 29	 A head of Waltham 29 broccoli, showing its dense, dark green florets and long, green stalks, with a wooden crate and a knife nearby.
